

Did Australia's gun laws really save 200 lives a year?

Background

- The number of firearm-related deaths was declining prior to Australia's 1996 gun laws. The decline continued after the legislative changes.
- Populist media and politicians have claimed that Australia's gun laws "saved about 200 lives annually". This claim has not been properly examined.

Numbers of deaths

- Table 1 shows actual numbers of firearm-related deaths in Australia, over a 30 year period¹, as well as the difference in numbers of deaths from one year to another.
- Taking into account the pre-existing downward trend in deaths, there is no evidence that 200 lives have been saved each year due to Australia's gun laws.
